PROJECT IMPACT

Increased climate resilience, sustainability and connectivity of Dominica’s road network; improved living conditions and livelihood opportunities for residents in the LGBR communities.



LOCATION

The Phase I section of Loubiere to Bagatelle Road is approximately 11 km in length, extending from the bridge at the Loubiere Junction to the Grand Bay Junction.



ACCESS

6,025 residents will benefit from improved essential access to all-weather, climate resilient and safe roads; with reduced travel times.



KEY ELEMENTS

- Road alignment, width, and safety.



ROAD WORKS

Bridges and Culverts:

- Replacement of four existing bridges,
- Construction of one new bridge,
- Removal and construction of several culverts.
